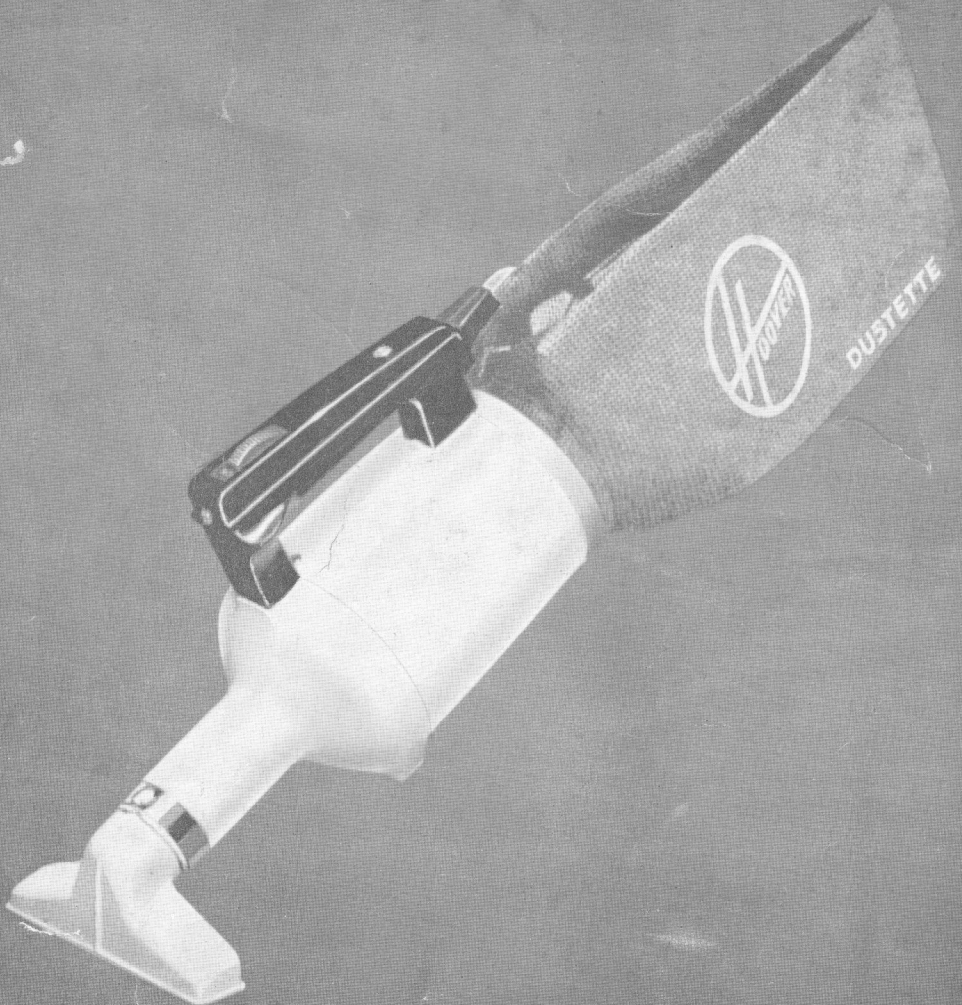




INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE USE AND CARE OF THE

DUSTETTE

MODEL 2614B



IMPORTANT

The Dustette operates on either alternating or direct current (A.C. or D.C.), but be sure that your electricity supply voltage is within the range marked on the cleaner nameplate which is situated underneath the cleaner nozzle.

Disconnect plug from electricity supply before making adjustments.

To assemble and use

To attach the bag, place the metal bag ring over the opening at the rear of the Dustette so that the top seam of the bag is slightly offset to the left of the handle. Press the ring firmly over the opening and turn it to the right until the bag ring locks in position. (Fig. 2.)

To empty the bag

To remove the bag from the Dustette turn the metal bag ring to the left until it is free. You can then easily dispose of the dirt.

It is advisable to empty the bag regularly, otherwise an accumulation of dirt will reduce the efficiency of the cleaner.

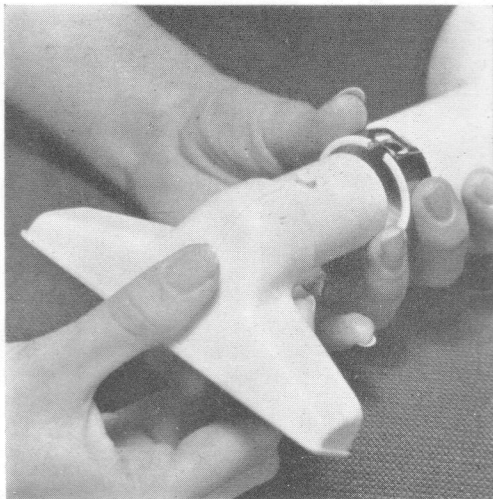

To remove the nozzle, press the sides of the spring clip together and pull the nozzle forward. (Fig. 1.)

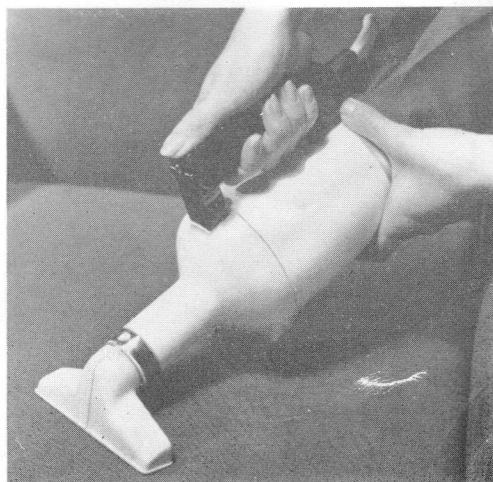
To store your Dustette

The Dustette should be kept in a cool, dry place away from radiators and damp atmosphere.

CLEANING TOOLS AVAILABLE AS AN OPTIONAL EXTRA

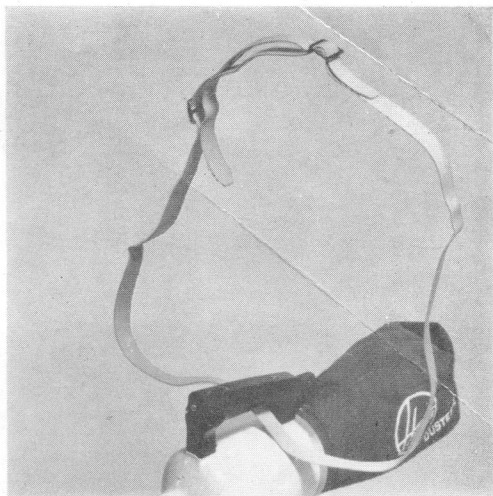

A set of cleaning tools is available as an optional extra. This greatly extends the range of whole-house cleaning and usefulness of your Dustette.

Assemble as in Fig. 3.

Simply line up the stud on the tool with the latch and push together. To separate, press the centre of the latch spring and pull apart.

Note

These tools are also used for another Hoover model. It is therefore necessary to make a simple adjustment to the carrying strap before use.

Release the buckle and discard the two spring clips which are not required. (Fig. 4.)

For convenience, the strap supports the cleaner over the shoulder. The end should be passed through the slot in the handle and buckled as shown.

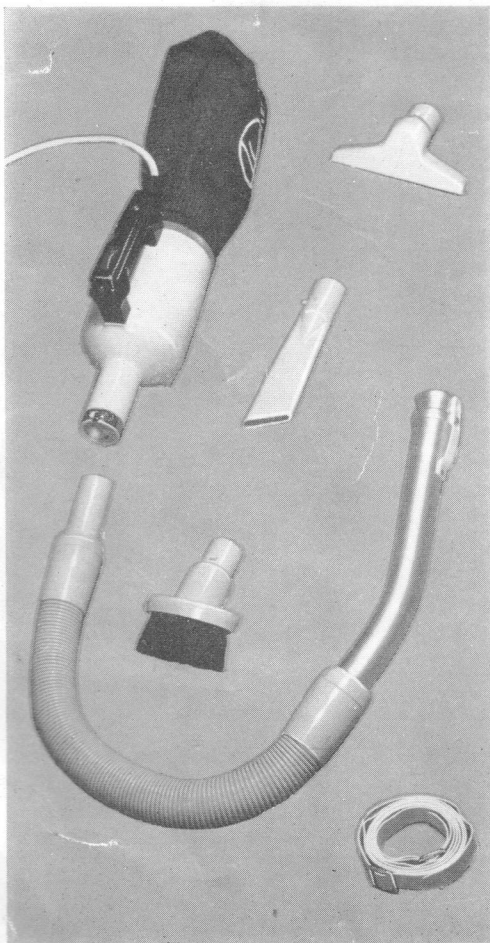
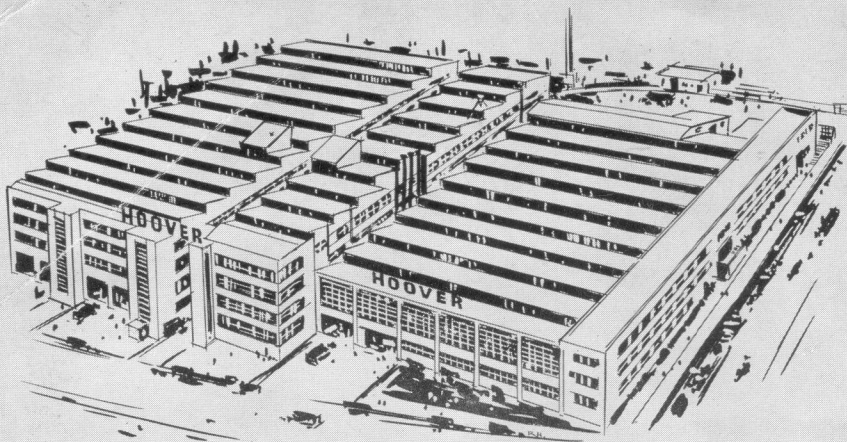

Any part judged defective by the Company will be exchanged for a replacement part; transportation costs involved in the repair of the appliance or the replacement of the defective part, shall be borne by the claimant.

It also becomes void if the product is used on the electric voltages other than that shown on the rating plate.
